

# The comma package\*

This package provides a means of producing numbers with a separator (by default a comma) every three digits.

Given a  $\text{\LaTeX}$  counter (eg `section`)

```
\renewcommand\thesection{\commaform{section}}
```

If `section` is 12345, `\thesection` will now print as 12,345

If you want something other than a comma, for instance a thin space, or a full word space, redefine `\commaformtoken`, for instance

```
\renewcommand\commaformtoken{\,}
```

```
\renewcommand\commaformtoken{ }
```
